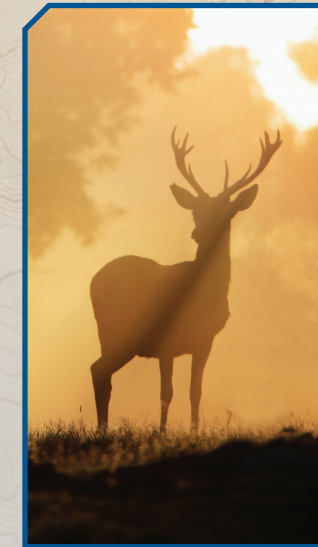

Each week will offer different themes and activities to keep the excitement going all summer. Our camp staff are trained to provide a safe and unforgettable experience. All staff are registered with the Boy Scouts of America and have completed the BSA's nationally recognized Youth Protection Training. Webelos Outdoor Adventure at Camp Yawgoog

For Scouts entering the 4th or 5th grade

Webelos Outdoor Adventure is a fantastic introduction to the Scouts, BSA Program while providing the additional adult supervision and structure still needed for Cub Scouts. Our Nationally Certified Staff is on hand to ensure a safe, successful and fun filled camping experience. All Webelos and parents will be housed in newly constructed Adirondack shelters. Den Leaders are welcome to attend but are not required. Parents wishing to attend must be registered with BSA and provide proof of Youth Protection Training at check-in. A Den or Pack sending four or more Scouts will be allowed to have one leader stay the week for free. Half week sessions are available (Sunday through Wednesday evening or Wednesday through Sunday). Program for Webelos Scouts will include but is not limited to: knot tying, BB range, archery, nature, pioneering, first aid, forestry, low-ropes, initiative games, handicap awareness trail, rowing, swimming, water sports, leatherwork, basketry, star gazing and hiking. Ample free time is also given to just take it easy.



FEES

- \$490 - Full Week (Sunday-Sunday)
- \$330 - Half Week (Half week option available from Sunday to Wednesday or Wednesday to Sunday).
- \$245 - Additional Weeks of Webelos Camp.
