#### **BOWL-A-THON INFORMATION**

#### **Setting Up your Bowl-a-Thon**

Contact a participating bowling alley to set up a date to go bowling. (See reverse) Some alleys will offer additional enhancements to their package (like pizza) which your unit will be able to purchase, if desired. Make sure to give each Scout a pledge sheet with plenty of time to get sponsors. Each sheet should have the Scout's name as well as the event location and time.

Collect the pledge sheets so they don't get lost!

#### Day of your Bowl-a-Thon

Have fun bowling!

When finished, return the pledge sheets and have each Scout mark down their two string pin total so they can collect their pledges.

Record the information on the Roster and Score Sheet for your records.
BE SURE TO FILL OUT THE ALLEY INVOICE WITH THE ALLEY AND SEND IT
TO THE COUNCIL OFFICE IMMEDIATELY SO THE ALLEY WILL GET PAID.
(Some alleys prefer to send it in themselves, please check with them.)

# After your Bowl-a-Thon

Each Scout should collect pledges and return them by their next meeting when possible.

Complete the Roster and Score sheet from the individual pledge sheets. Keep 40% of the collected proceeds for your unit and send the balance to the Council office. This money pays for the alley, patches, materials with the balance going toward camperships, camp improvements and other Scouting expenses.

All transactions should be completed within 2 weeks of your bowling date. Patches will be available at the next roundtable in your community.
