PARADE FIELDS

Lower Parade field is approximately 3/4 acre of fully open area for opening/closing ceremonies and activities. Flagpoles have a natural pool in background and brook on right side. Upper Parade Field is extremely larges and slopping to a vast 1 3/4 acres. It can be accessed from the road or through the walking trails that lead from the lower parade field. AMPHITHEATRE

WALKING TRAILS

Approximately 1-2 miles of walking trails around camp. Well marked and easy to follow. A good trip on the trails will show the many different types of trees and shrubs at the camp. Another great opportunity to complete advancement requirements.
