District Award of Merit	District Awards Committee	Highest District-level award given to someone who has given extraordinary service over many years.
Chartered Org/Sponsor of the Year	District Awards Committee	Awarded to the Chartered partner/sponsor whose dedication to their scouting units is unsurpassed.
Scoutmaster of the Year	District Awards Committee	Awarded to the Scoutmaster who has risen above his/her peers in their service to their scouts and troop.
Cubmaster of the Year	District Awards Committee	Awarded to the Cubmaster who has risen above his/her peers in their service to their scouts and pack.

Lifesaving & Meritorious Action	Nom by unit; through Council to National	For Scouts and Scouters who have performed an attempt to save a life or other notable acts of service.
Veteran's	Registrar/National (depending on tenure)	Once registered leaders submits paperwork, tenure (less than 20 years) is checked by registrar or National (20+)
Venturing Leadership	Council, Area, Region or National	For Venturers and Venturing Advisors who have made exceptional contributions to Venturing.
Sea Scout Leadership	Council, Area, Region or National	For Sea Scouts and Sea Scouters who have made exceptional contributions to the Sea Scout Program.
Unit Leader Award of Merit	Nominated by unit's top youth leader	Scout Leader who has attained seven benchmarks characteristic of strong units. Signed off by commissioner.
Conservation Good Turn	Nominated by Unit or District	For packs, troops, crews, and ships to join with conservation/environmental organizations to carry out a Good Turn.
Torch of Gold	Nominated by Unit or District	Awarded to youth or adults for outstanding work with scouts with special needs.
