<u>Statement by the Hopkinton Police Department</u>

At approximately 0700HRS on July 16th 2011, members of the Hopkinton Police Department and Hope Valley Ambulance Squad were called to Yawgoog Scout Reservation which is a part of the Narragansett Council, Boy Scouts of America located in Rockville, Rhode Island. Upon the arrival of emergency workers, a 10 year old male was pronounced deceased and the Rhode Island Medical Examiner's Office was called. The Rhode Island Medical Examiner's Office has scheduled an autopsy for this afternoon. The boy's family, from Huntington, NY, has been notified. There's no indication of foul play. This case remains under investigation by the Hopkinton Police Department and the State Medical Examiner's Office.
