- \$350 due by Feb. 1, 2012; another \$350 due by Apr. 1, 2012; remaining \$300 due by June 1, 2012
- Actual cost is affected by many factors, including number of participants. Budget includes a contingency for unanticipated expenses. Excess will be returned to participants during or after conference.
