RESPONSIBILITIES and SAMPLE SCHEDULE

4:30 pm	Join the Overnight Staff for a meeting at the registration area. Review your schedule for the evening and meet staff. Follow the leadership and direction of the Overnight Staff – you are responsible to them all evening.
5:00-7:00 pm	With Overnight Staff, greet participants at the Garage entrance, assist with gear storage, give information and directions. Help clean up registration.
7:15 pm	Attend Instructor meeting and meet the Instructor you will be assisting.
7:30 pm	Help your Instructor set up. If everything's all set, attend the Opening Welcome show in Cahners Theater.
8:00-10:15 pm	Assist Instructor with hands-on science workshop and snack time activity stations. Help set up and clean up workshop materials.
10:15-10:30 pm	Help Instructors return supplies to supply room and clean up.
10:30-10:45 pm	Help Staff and overnight participants in the gear storage area
10:45-11:15 pm	Observe Late show and assist participants with gear afterwards.
Midnight	Set up your designated sleeping area. Lights out. Good Night! zzzz
6:30 – 8:00 am	Everyone WAKES UP!!! Pack up your stuff! Help direct participants to the garage and the Café. Assist groups with packing up as needed. Help Overnight Staff serve breakfast. Eat some!
8:00-10:00 am	Join groups at Planetarium and OMNI show help with Lost and Found.
