

SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE FOR SCOUTS

The American Legion Eagle Scout of the Year

Requirements:

- Be a registered, active member of a Boy Scout Troop, Varsity Scout Team, or Venturing Crew chartered to an American Legion Post, Auxiliary Unit or Sons of the American Legion Squadron; or, be a registered, active member of a duly chartered Boy Scout Troop, Varsity Scout Team, or Venturing Crew, and the son or grandson of a Legionnaire or Auxiliary member.
- Received the Eagle Scout Award.
- Be an active member of his religious institution and must have received the appropriate Boy Scout Religious emblem.
- Have demonstrated practical citizenship in church, school, Scouting and community.
- Have reached his 15th birthday and be enrolled in high school at the time of selection.

Deadline for submission to Department Headquarters: March 1st.

Bristol Community College - Joshua M. Revier Eagle Scout Scholarship

Requirements:

- The individual must have attained Eagle Scout rank as verified by the National Eagle Scout Association prior to submission.
- The scholarship will be awarded to a Bristol Community College Eagle Scout student who demonstrates scholastic merit with a 3.0 or better grade point average..
- The scholarship will be awarded to a Bristol Community College Eagle Scout student who demonstrates financial need.

Application Requirements:

- The scholarship application is ONLY available on-line (if the applicant is registered for courses) at <https://bristolcc.academicworks.com>.
 - Applications will be accepted between **March 1, 2017 and June 30, 2017**.
 - The Scholarship funds (which consists of \$1,000 per academic year--\$500 fall semester/\$500 spring semester) will be awarded in the academic school year.

Boy Scouts of America
National Eagle Scout Scholarships

Requirements Include:

- Be an Eagle Scout and have received credentials from the National Office.
- Submit applications that are postmarked after October 1 but no later than midnight on December 31st.
- Be a graduating high school senior entering college in the year a scholarship is applied for. Scholarships are awarded only to those who graduate from high school in the calendar year in which scholarships are presented.

Deadline for applications is December 31st.

National Eagle Scout Merit Scholarships

Requirements Include:

- Be an Eagle Scout and have received credentials from the National Office.
- Submit applications that are postmarked after October 1 but no later than midnight on December 31st.
- Be a graduating high school senior or an undergraduate college student no later than completion of the junior year. You may receive the scholarship one time only.

Deadline for applications is December 31st.

- Any Eagle Scout is eligible to apply who is still registered actively in a Scout unit provided that he does NOT reach his 19th birthday in the calendar year of application.
- Completed four generations Ancestry Chart.
- Your original essay, not to exceed 500 words, written on an American Revolutionary Patriotic Theme, with footnotes and bibliography.

Requirements:

- Be a registered, active member of a Boy Scout Troop, Venturing Crew, or Sea Scout Ship.
- Have received the Eagle Scout Award, Venture Silver Award or Quartermaster Award.
- Have demonstrated practical citizenship in school, Scouting and community.
- Have reached his/her 15th birthday and is enrolled in high school at the time of selection.
- Have submitted his/her complete entry to a VFW Post in his/her community.
