

What is Scoutbook?

Scoutbook is a website designed for mobile devices. Scoutbook delivers a suite of easy-to-use Web-based tools that are helpful to Scouts, parents and unit leaders. It enables units to better communicate, update records, track advancement and manage activities.

Den Leaders should check out the new Den Leaders Experience section which can help them organize their whole year! Troops can now search for Merit Badge Counselors who've created profiles on Scoutbook. New features are being added all the time!

How do I start?

Simply go to www.Scoutbook.com and log in using your My.Scouting.org credentials! If your unit has never used Scoutbook before then a member of the unit's Key-3 must log in to approve other leaders as Admins.

What are Admins?

Troop and Pack Admins and Den Admins are leaders who have accounts on Scoutbook who help manage the unit. This position is assigned by selecting the button "Add Position/Role" within that leader's profile.

Is training available?

Yes. Training and help resources are found at Help.Scoutbook.com.

Can I port my third-party unit-management vendor data to Scoutbook?

No, there will be no need to port data from other third-party vendors. Scoutbook will link to all unit membership data directly from ScoutNet, the Council's database.

Can I still use other third-party unit-management vendors once Scoutbook launches? Although, Scoutbook will be made available to all units, they may continue to use other third-party applications. However, Scoutbook will be the only unit-management system fully integrated with the BSA database.

What is Scoutbook's relationship to ScoutNET and Internet Advancement 2.0? Scoutbook communicates awards and advancement directly with ScoutNET.

Internet Advancement has been upgraded to Internet Advancement 2.0. Although both systems communicate with ScoutNET, <u>only one platform should be used for advancement</u> to avoid duplication of records.

How do I find Advancement Reports?

Advancement Reports are available from the Purchase Order screen after the "Need Purchasing Report.


Who should I contact for questions?
