WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

To be eligible to attend a National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT), a scout must:

Be a registered member of a BSA Troop, Venturing Crew or Sea Scout Crew or Explorer Post.

- **Scouts:** Be between 13 and 17 years of age and be a 1st Class Scout by start of the course
- **Venture's & Sea Scouts and Explorers:** Be between 14 and 20 years of age and have completed their 1st rank requirement.
- Have Unit Leaders approval.

After attending NYLT, consider extending your leadership development by participating on staff.
